

ADMISSIONS QUALIFICATIONS

Essex County College (ECC) admits any person who is at least 18 years of age and has earned a high school diploma or General Education Development (GED) certificate or who is a graduate of an approved home schooled program. High school diploma, GED or equivalent is not required for admission to ECC but is required to receive federal financial aid and admission to Nursing and Health Sciences programs. This open admission policy does not guarantee acceptance to all degree or certificate programs in Nursing and Health Sciences; these programs have additional admissions requirements.
