## **TUITION AND FEES**

Tuition and fees at ECC are established by the College's Board of trustees. Those presented here are for the 2023-24 academic year only.

## **Tuition**

Tuition is based on the total number of credit hours or instructional hours for which a student registers. Fees are non-refundable except for course cancellations and for withdrawals during the first week of classes. Essex County College reserves the right, with no prior notice, to restructure tuition and fee rates.



## New ECC Student Account Center for On-Line Tuition & Fee Payments

The new online **Student Account Center** is a one stop, comprehensive tuition payment portal that allows you to view your financial information on a single screen, see charges and payments related to your tuition account and make online payments in a 24/7 online format. The online Student Account Center is accessible through the Essex County College student portal at <a href="mailto:myportal-essex.edu">myportal-essex.edu</a>.

Students or authorized users can make full payment or enroll in the ECC tuition payment plan with ACH payments deducted directly from your bank checking or savings account or by using Visa, MasterCard, Discover, or American Express credit cards. You may also set up recurring tuition payments and have them automatically deducted from a bank account or credit or debit card on their due date.

If you are awarded financial aid for a semester, installment payments will now be reduced to reflect the amount of the award.

A 2.95% service fee or \$3 minimum fee is charged for processing credit or debit card payments. This fee is established by the credit card processor. There are no fees charged for ACH tuition payments deducted from a bank account.

Effective January 1, 2024, all credit and debit card tuition and fee payments are required to be submitted through the Student Account Center at <a href="mayportal.essex.edu">myportal.essex.edu</a> The Bursar's Office will continue to accept payments made by cash, check or money order.

Actively using the online Student Account Center throughout the semester is crucial to your success. Be sure to sign in regularly to keep up to date with your student account status as well as important financial information.
